Water and Wastewater Maintenance Person

The Town of Ticonderoga is seeking to fill the full-time position of Water and Wastewater Maintenance Person. The successful candidate will be selected on the basis of qualifications, knowledge, experience, general intelligence, and mechanical aptitude.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Repair water mains, service lines, valves and hydrants;
- Clean and release plugged and broken wastewater lines;
- Operate pumps, valves, motors and related machinery and equipment;
- Perform maintenance work and make minor repairs to machinery and equipment;
- Perform routine manual labor functions such as digging, building maintenance, repairs, etc.
- Clean channels, screens, tanks and other equipment;
- Maintain inventories of meters, pipes, and supplies necessary for operation of water and wastewater systems;
- Check level and condition of reservoirs and other water sources;
- Receive and investigate complaints from customers;
- Read, remove and reset water meters in and around the homes of residents;

Minimum Qualifications: Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and one year of experience in the plumbing field and meet the minimum qualifications to be eligible for the applicable Distribution System Operator's License.
