TICONDEROGA**


EFFECTIVE: 3:19 P.M. on May 17, 2020

This State of Emergency has been previously declared due to the COVID-19/Coronavirus threat. The Supervisor hereby finds that this situation continues to threaten public safety and the health, safety and welfare of the public. This extended State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order or the expiration of 30 days from the date of this declaration unless further extended.

As the Chief Executive of the Town of Ticonderoga, I, Joseph M. Giordano, exercise the authority given me under section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of the Town of Ticonderoga. I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Town of Ticonderoga to take whatever steps necessary to protect life, property, and public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
