- The historical society is doing a presentation on working women and have asked if we have any photos of former librarians. There are none in the library.
- The selection from "Patches and Patterns Extended" regarding the Silas Paine collection was distributed to the Board.
- We are still investigating insurance options for the library. We are looking for a quote for D&O Liability Insurance. It is unclear if we also need Property & General Liability as the library is a Town building.
- The New York State Public Library Construction Grant application is open. Applications for projects will be accepted through June 2, 2023.
- Orkin came to the library several months ago regarding many issues. We are still waiting for the report and a resolution to the problems of mice, bees and ants.
- The Annual Report has been submitted to the library system for final editing.
- There has been no resolution regarding the purchase of the new copier.

- Steve Boyce reported that the asbestos inspection on the building to be demolished has been done. No asbestos was found, and the next step is to obtain a demolition permit.
- A motion was made to pay for the inspection from the library fund by Cheryl O'Connor and seconded by Susan Gravelle.
