- Foster Care
- Homeless
- Reading or Math skills below 9th grade level
- English Language Learner or English Second Language

Supportive Services

- Clothing, uniforms
- Medical Examinations
- Transportation and childcare needs.

Gift cards may be provided for reaching following goals:

Completing training course;
increase in reading and math skills;
earning Highschool equivalency;
meeting all program requirements,
starting a new job.

Funding:

- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) program—152 hour instruction & training. Certification is available.
- Welding Program—MIG,TIG and Arc Welding and the application of oxyacetylene cutting weld prep.
- Assembly Industry: Manufacturing and Education (AIME) - Hands on learning activities around manufacturing, blueprint reading, power tools and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Certification.
