# What level skier or snowboarder are you?

## <u>Ski</u>

#### First Time/Beginner

Level 1 - Have never skied before. Welcome to skiing! We're going to help you build a foundation of good balance and begin to slide, glide, and turn.

#### **Novice Zone**

- Level 2 Have skied once before and can glide in a wedge. May have some difficulties turning and controlling speed. May or may not have ridden a lift. We'll help you to turn and control your speed.
- Level 3 Can make wedge turns in both directions. Have ridden a lift. We'll help you vary your turn shapes and sizes and explore more beginner terrain.

## **Snowboard**

### First Time/Beginner

Level 1 – Have never-ever snowboarded before. Welcome to riding! We're going to help you build a foundation of good balance and begin to slide, glide, and turn.

#### **Novice Zone**

Level 2 - Have ridden once before. You can traverse the slope. You can also skid on toe-side and heel-side, and make J-Turns. May have some difficulties turning and controlling speed. May or may not have ridden a lift. We'll help you turn and control your speed.

#### Intermediate Zone

Level 3 – You can link turns, stop on demand, and do ground spins. Have ridden a lift. We'll help you vary your turn shapes and sizes to conquer Green terrain and explore Blue terrain.



# Gore Regional School Program 2023-24 - SATURDAYS

Welcome all program schools! Once again, we are offering a ski/ride program for your school/town for the 23-24 season.

We will continue to offer this program to your students on Saturdays, as we have done in the past couple seasons.

In addition, while the program is open to all students of all levels, ages 7-18, to ski/ride for 6 weeks, LESSONS are only available for levels 1-3 skiers & snowboarders. That means first time students and those thru the novice level will be able to take lessons in the weekend program. All other participants, levels 4+, can ski/ride on their own for the day, each week for the 6-wk program. See attached ski/ride level descriptions that you can share with your students for registration purposes.

The lessons are 1 hr. in duration, from 8:30 - 9:30am. Lessons meet at 8:15, out front of the Northwoods Lodge.

Lift tickets will be valid for the entire day, so after their lessons end at 9:30 they can ski/ride the remainder of the day. Those not taking lessons can ski/ride all day.

Your town/school program day is **SATURDAYS**.

- Program dates are Jan 6,20,27, Feb 3,10,24\*
  - \* no program MLK wkend Jan 13, nor Pres wkend Feb 17

We are also offering the Thurs/Fri NORDIC program at the Ski Bowl this season.

- Program dates are Jan 4,5,11,12,18,19, 25,26, Feb 1,2, 8,9, 2024
- Nordic lessons are 5:00 6:30pm at the Ski Bowl

Students participating in the Gore Regional School program must still be enrolled in your local school system, as in the past.

Returning students can use their same pass photo as last year, if the photo is less than 3 yrs old. All students new to the program will need a photo -- a head shot, no hat, no dark goggles/glasses. Parents can email their child's photo, along with full name, school name, and 'GRS program' to:

Or they may come to Gore Mtn Box Office, and we'll take their photo, 8:00 - 4:00, 7 days week, prior to Dec 1, 2023.

## Required Registration Information:

Parents can register their child(ren) by completing the digital Registration Form, and returning to you, the program Advisor. Once you gather all your registration forms, you will enter all the student info on the excel spreadsheet. The individual registrations and the excel summary of students should all be emailed to myself and Taylor Howard by December 1, 2023.

Parents MUST sign the electronic Terms & Conditions Assumption of Risk Waiver to allow their children in the program. If the waiver is not signed, the child cannot participate. This waiver needs to be signed once they have completed their registration form. The link to the electronic signature will be emailed to each student's parent email once we receive their completed registration forms. This email link will come from ORDA Reservations, not from Gore Mountain.

## **Additional info:**

On program days, each child must check in at our 'check-in' cabin, by Northwoods Lodge, near the rental shop doors.

For every 10 participants in your program, your town/school will receive 1 complimentary lift ticket each week. These comp tickets are to be used by Chaperones that will be available at lesson check-in, to meet students when lessons are over, as well as be available to your students throughout the day for any issues.

In addition to the complementary lift tickets, discounted chaperone tickets will also be available for purchase a discounted rate of \$82/person. These <u>chaperone</u> tickets are limited to **5** for each school, each week.

A list of all chaperone names should be submitted to Gore prior to start of your program. Then, each week on Thursday before that weekend, please email the specific names of the 5 people who will be purchasing the chaperone tickets that weekend to Taylor, our Box Office Supervisor <a href="mailto:thousand-com/">thousand-com/</a>.

We look forward to having your school/town participate in our program this season.
